

Aracoma Kitchen Crew Patch Requirements

1. Must be a current paid member of Aracoma lodge and in good standings with the lodge.
2. Member should ask and receive permission from the kitchen committee chair, youth kitchen committee chair & head cook to work in kitchen, dining area, etc.
3. Each individual must work 4 of the 5 lodge events from the start of the event until the end of the event (full weekend).
4. All members working in the food service area must follow all BSA, local, state and national food service policies.
5. Kitchen chair shall be responsible for maintaining records and submitting request for patches to the awards committee or lodge adviser immediately after fall fellowship or November 1st, whichever is the later.
6. You must attend the annual lodge banquet to receive your kitchen crew patch. In the case that the lodge banquet is not held, the head of the kitchen committee shall make arrangements to disperse patches at the next available function. Awards not collected at the banquet will be returned to the lodge for future use.
7. Awards shall be reordered as needed and any necessary changes or updates to the award will be determined by the Cooking Committee for that calendar year.
8. These requirements shall be reviewed annually by the LEC and adjusted as the lodge schedule dictates change.
